The Wonders of Portugal



Day 1 &2 : Arrival Day and discovering

After Arriving will start discovering Guimarães and its secrets. Guimarães is a city in Minho, Portugal and is one of the most historical cities in Portugal, said to be where "Portugal was born". It is the first city of Portugal, and have a beautiful Castle, and a Palace to visit, from the beginnings of the country. The Castle has been classified as one of the New Portuguese Seven Wonders.

Day 3: Porto the world heritage

Will start the third day by Porto , Porto is a busy industrial and commercial centre, The city was built along the hills overlooking the Douro river estuary, and its historical center was awarded World Heritage status by UNESCO in 1996. Porto has a semi-Mediterranean climate, although it's strongly affected by the Atlantic Ocean, which makes it cooler than other cities with this climate. However, temperatures can rise as high as 40°C in August during occasional heat waves. We can't forget that Porto wine it's famous and the city classified as world heritage

Day 4: Douro Valley

The Douro is one of the major rivers of the Iberian Peninsula, Will approach Douro valleyThe vineyards of the Douro valley, World Heritage since 2001, and represent the oldest demarcated wine. You will have the opportunity to visit farms producers of wine, to have a trip by train and by the typical Rabelo boat, enjoying the scenery.

Day 5: Archaeological Park of Côa Valley

Early in the morning, will reach the Archaeological Park of the Côa Valley. The goal of the entire complex of the Côa Valley Archaeological Park is to provide its visitors with a singular version of a unique and striking space in the History of human artistic and social evolution. Created in 1996 to protect and turn local rock art into a museum, Côa Valley Archaeological Park has a visit system which promotes the balance between enjoying the space to its fullest and preserving both the engravings, dating back thousands of years, and the landscape which shelters them.

Day 6: centre, Coimbra.

After finishing from Douro region, will continue to the country centre, and our stop will be in Coimbra the capital of the Portuguese knowledge. In terms of historic significance and romantic beauty, Coimbra is second only to Lisbon and Porto. Its ancient buildings cling to the side of the hill that rises above the curves of the river Mondego; the ornate buildings of the famous University of Coimbra are its crowning glory.

Day 7: Monastery of Batalha, Tomar

Wake up in a fantastic morning; be ready to visit the monastery of Batalha near the place where an important battle for the consolidation of Portugal as an independent nation took place in 1385. It was classified in 1983. Then will go to Tomar city in Portugal, in the centre of the country, in Médio Tejo subregion. Tomar is a small city but holds an important ancient past and some of the most important monuments in Portugal, where it is the Convent of Christ, World Heritage since 1983. Then, you will admire the Monastery of Alcobaça, classified in 1989. In spite of being almost 900 years old, it keeps its divisions intact and all its splendour. You will

end the day in Óbidos, a medieval city, perfectly preserved, surrounded by walls and looking like an illustrated postcard.

Day 8: Lisbon

After finishing from Porto will go to Lisbon to accommodate for 3 nights the capital of Portugal, Lisbon has experienced a renaissance in recent years, with a contemporary culture that is alive and thriving and making its mark in today's Europe.

Day 9: Exploring Lisbon

In a fantastic and warm day will start exploring Lisbon the beautiful city, and will stop at the Monastery of Jerónimos, World Heritage since 1983, a precious jewel from the kingdom of D. Manuel I. Another stop must be at the Tower of Belém, also classified in 1983.

Day 10: Sintra

Towards the romantic atmosphere in Sintra where we can find the full refreshing and notable monuments, which is classified natural scenery in 1995.

Day 11: Elvas, Évora

Will start the day with the fortified city of Elvas which was classified in 2012. And will visit Évora, a city considered a living museum, whose city centre was classified in 1986. The tour will end here, Portugal is one of the world wonders you should visit and discover.
