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ITINERARY

DAY 01 - KANDY

On arrive in Sri Lanka, you will be welcomed and assisted by a representative of Jetwing Travels and you will be then transferred to your Kandy hotel via Pinnawela & Mawanella.

PINNAWALA ELEPHANT ORPHANAGE – Approx. 55 miles from Colombo, off the Colombo - Kandy road is Pinnawela. Here an orphanage was started in 1975 to house abandoned and wounded elephants. The number of elephants has increased to more than 65 now; including baby elephants brought from various parts, as well more than 25 babies born because of the captive breeding programme.

SPICE GARDEN – You will see many spice gardens at Mawanella on the Colombo-Kandy road where Cinnamon, Cardamom, Pepper Creepers and all other spice trees, plants and creepers are planted for visitors to see them. **KANDY**, including Upper Lake Drive, Market Square, Arts & Crafts Centre, Gem Museum & Temple of Tooth Relic. Kandy the hill capital, venue of the annual Perahera the last stronghold of the Sinhala Kings was finally ceded to the British in 1815. Kandy is an example of the Buddhism's influence in Sri Lanka today.

By the night experience a **CULTURAL SHOW** where you will be taken to mind blowing Sri Lankan culture extravaganza... Get ready for Heavy drumbeat and acrobatic act.

DAY 02: KANDY - NUWARA

TEMPLE OF TOOTH RELIC ever since 4th Century A.D, when the Buddha's Tooth was brought to Sri Lanka hidden from sacrilegious hands in an Orissan princess' hair, the Relic has grown in repute and holiness in Sri Lanka and throughout the Buddhist world. It is considered Sri Lanka's most prized possession.

ROYAL BOTANICAL GARDENS, PERADENIYA This majestic botanical garden is 147 acres in extent and was started in 1374 as a pleasure garden of the Kings of Gampola and Kandy. There are more than 5,000 species of trees, plants and creepers.

RAMBODA FALLS Located next to the road between Kandy and Nuwara Eliya, Ramboda Falls is one of the highest waterfalls in Sri Lanka, standing at over one hundred meters tall, and is undoubtedly one of Sri Lanka's most picturesque. It is most definitely worth a stop off during your tour of the area given the stunning surroundings and countless photo opportunities that arise.

Enjoy **"TEA EXPERIENCE",** which involves a visit a plantation to observe firsthand the process, starting from the plucking field where it all begins with the picking of "two leaves and a bud" to the factory where the processing begins. A guided tour around a Tea Factory is an enlightening experience.

Overnight stay at Nuwara Eliya

DAY 03: MUWARA ELIYA

Breakfast at the hotel.

NUWARA ELIYA the 'Little England' of Sri Lanka, is set against beautiful backdrops of Mountains, Valleys, Waterfalls and Tea Plantations. It is supposed to be one of the coolest places in the Island, but it is just like an English spring day, although the temperature does drop at night.

HORTON PLAINS NATIONAL PARK is a protected area in the central highlands of Sri Lanka and is covered by montane grassland and cloud forest. This plateau at an altitude of 2,100–2,300 metres is rich in biodiversity and many species found here are endemic to the region.

LAKE GREGORY is one of the significant tourist attractions in Nuwara Eliya. With recent up liftmen in Nuwara Eliya area many recreation facilities introduced around the Gregory lake area.

VICTORIA PARK, an immaculately kept public park which spreads out over an area in excess of twenty five acres. Victoria Park is very popular among bird lovers with the park being home to a number of endemic species which are supported by the Nanu Oya River and lakes that are situated in the park.

Overnight stay at Nuwara Eliya

DAY 04: NUWARA ELIYA - ELLA

Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out and proceed to Ella by Train.

The **TRAIN JOURNEY** from **Nuwara Eliya** (Nanu Oya Station, 8 km outside of **Nuwara Eliya**) **to Ella** takes about 2-3 hours and goes through a beautiful landscape of tea plantations. You should sit on the left side of the **train** from **Nuwara Eliya to Ella** as this side is the most scenic.

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THE NINE ARCH BRIDGE also called the Bridge in the Sky, is a viaduct bridge in Sri Lanka. It is one of the best examples of colonial-era railway construction in the country. The construction of the bridge is generally attributed to a local Ceylonese builder, P. K. Appuhami, in consultation with British engineers.

RAVANA FALLS is a popular sightseeing attraction in Sri Lanka. It currently ranks as one of the widest falls in the country.

Overnight stay at Ella with a romantic Candle light dinner.

DAY 05: ELLA - BENTOTA

Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out and proceed to Bentota.

LIPTON SEAT striking panoramas draw visitors to this overlook & cafe near historic tea-producing farms. From Lipton's Seat the Uva, Sabaragamuwa, Central and Eastern provinces spread out from before the feet of the viewer in a display rivaling that of the famed World's End observation point. Visible from the hill top are 7 provinces along with sights such as Handapanagala Lake, Chandrika Lake, Udawalawe Lake, Wedihitikanda Mountains, and even the Hambanthota harbor from the Southern coast.

Overnight stay at Bentota

DAY 06: BENTOTA - AIRPORT

Breakfast at the hotel.

MADU RIVER BOAT RIDE in the 915-hectare Maadu Ganga Estuary is connected by two narrow channels to the Randombe Lake, forming a complex wetland system encompassing 64 mangrove islets. In the year 2000, International Union for the Conservation of Nature (IUCN) undertook a detailed biodiversity survey of the region & revealed the existence of no less than 10 major wetland vegetation types supporting over 300 plant species & 248 species of vertebrates.

MARINE TURTLE Conservation in Kosgoda... Globally, all seven species of marine turtles are endangered. Of these seven, five come ashore to nest in Sri Lanka. The process of marine turtles nesting, hatchlings being born, and swimming back to sea is fascinating to observe.

Evening proceed to do some WATER SPORTS (Jet Ski, Banana Ride, Boat Ride, Tube Ride, etc....)

Overnight stay at Bentota.

DAY 07 – BENTOTA - AIRPORT

Though it will be difficult to say goodbye, all good things come to an end. Your representative from Jetwing Travels will meet you on time at the hotel lobby to return you by way of a scenic drive to the international airport for your departing flight and a safe journey home.
